Launch of 3rd Edition of Notaries of Europe Open Days

Brussels, 18 October 2018 – The 3rd edition of the Notaries of Europe Open Days opens on Monday 22 October. In 14 countries of the European Union, events will be organised for citizens and students: information sessions, conferences and free consultations at which several thousand people are expected.
